Definitions	 Students are K5 (Kindergarten) through 12. No charge for preschool. College students are considered adults. A family is considered one family unit (parents/guardians and their children). Extended family members are additional units. CICC passes are NOT valid for IACS tournament admission. Pastors, Administrators, Coaches, Athletic Directors and their spouses are admitted free but will need to sign in at the gate table and will also need a hand stamp each day. Pastors are defined as any of the pastoral staff from the church associated with one of the participating schools. 					

- Administrators are defined as the head administrator or principal from a participating school. This does NOT include assistant principals in preschool, elementary or high school.
- Soccer/volleyball players can attend the opposite sport at no charge if they wear their jerseys or team . clothing as a tournament team identifier. Players will need to get their hands stamped for access.
