Please be on time to the rehearsals you are involved in! Rehearsal Dress Code: We require neatness, cleanliness, and modesty. The same standards

will be enforced during the day and for the concert. Violations of the dress code will be dealt with appropriately.

- **1. Girls and ladies** are required to wear skirts or dresses that will be to the middle of the knee or longer (when seated), and necklines will not be low or open in the front or back. No slacks, jeans, or shorts will be allowed.
- **2. Boys and men** are required to wear neat shirts, tucked in, with a collar and dress pants with a belt. Jeans and shorts are not to be worn on campus. Hair should be short with no long sideburns. No beards or mustaches will be permitted on students.

**Conduct Code:** Patience, kindness, and good behavior are the rule to follow at all times for students and adults. Insubordination or disruptive behavior by any student or adult toward any authority will not be tolerated and will be grounds for dismissal from the event. Any individual vandalizing or stealing will be dismissed and their school shall be fined in an amount equal to the cost of repairs or replacement.

## **Concert Attire:**

- 1. Girls and ladies same as previously outlined; additionally: All black attire; no low necklines or long slits that rise above the knee; no sheer blouses. Sleeves are preferred above sleeveless. No exposed backlines. No Heels should be worn (to help with choir positions/height to remain the same.)
- **2. Boys and men** are required to wear all-black attire, button-up dress shirts, tucked in, with a tie (optional coat or suit), dress slacks and dress shoes.

**Band Members:** Please bring your instrument, music, pencil, and all accessories pertaining to your instrument. This is your responsibility, not your Director's. ©

**Choir Members:** Please bring your own music, pencil and <u>black music</u> <u>folder for the concert</u>. This is your responsibility, not your Director's. ☺
